



SAINT GABRIEL SCHOOL PLAYGROUND

The story started when the St. Gabriel [SG] parish community needed to build a Catholic middle and high school in Lascahobas, Haiti to make higher education available and safe to the students. A generous parishioner at SG donated a piece of land to build the school and the campus. Foundations were laid March 1, 2010, just a few weeks after the January 10, 2010, earthquake. After the tragic seism, the community needed a project to bring them together in hope. This was that project. The school, currently serving first Grade through 13th Grade, opened in September 2012. Each year, a grade was added to the lower and upper schools.

In 2020, to draw enrollment and improve education and safety, the pastor at SG wished to utilize the current space in front of the school to build a playground. His goal was to educate the whole person: spiritually, intellectually, and physically. One study, published by the National Library of Medicine, shows how students who are involved in outdoor activities are healthier and can do better in school. Outdoor athletics keep students in school with good health while improving their ability to focus on academics. The high school students use it to play soccer, volleyball, and basketball; lower and middle school students will use it as a playground.

- PE curriculum development
- A safe place to play
- Physical and social development
- Sport competitions and teamwork
- Well-being and health

- Healthy and constructive community

BASIC DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT:

- Clear the area of rocks and dirt DONE
- Level ground and a small hill *DONE*
- Build a wall of retention DONE
- Lay a foundation DONE
- Concrete surfacing DONE sept. 2021
- Bleachers on one side facing the school *UPCOMING*



The pastor at SG raised 10% of the needed funds through tuition. Similarly, the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) participated in some of the work, logistics, cleanup, and provisions of food and water. Sacred Heart contributed funds from its St. Gabriel Building and Outfitting Fund. The school is responsible for maintaining the playground. This project had a timeline of the work, provided updates and pictures of the progress made. Students and teachers wrote short reflections on the playground's merit. This encouraged them to take ownership of their new playground.
