HAITI TWINNING MINISTRY ANNUAL REPORT | 2023 marks Sacred Heart's 16<sup>th</sup> year in twinning with St. Gabriel Parish. Fr. Fitho JEAN has been the parish priest there for two years. In 2022-2023 Sacred Heart and the greater community supported its twin parish/school this way: salaries for 8 teachers and 1 nurse, lunch fees for 16 students, 2 sets of high school books, 21 tuition scholarships, and some medical assistance. We have also invested in a water filter system which will allow St. Gabriel to save funds by filtering their own water. Also, we continue to slowly decrease assistance with the operational cost at the school.
