Or if one part of our body is honored, all the other parts share its honor. Together you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of that body. 2-What are the root causes of the suffering of the Haitian people? What can I/we do about it? <u>BEGINNING OF YEAR</u>: <u>Description of Each Fund</u> reviewed by Patricia—Sc hool Staff Fund—6 teachers (8 last year) & 1 nurse (\$100 monthly/each); <u>Lunch Fund</u>—11 students (16 last year) (\$420 annually each); <u>Medical Fund</u>—\$100 monthly, medication purchased on local economy plus dental visit \$550; <u>Building & Outfitting Fund/Sustainable Projects</u>—1 set of high school books & 1 water filter system/investing in sustainable projects; <u>Scholarship Fund</u>—20 students at St. Gabriel (\$275 annually each) & 1 student at the normal school (Teacher College) (\$410 annually).
