St. Gabriel School Year 2023-2024—Patricia noted that the entire school started on 9/11/2023 with Mass; entire school completed the 1st Quarter with exams and started the 2nd Quarter on Nov 7; enrollment was the highest due to a strong school, pre/K-13th Grade/754 students; very good administrators; close to excellent scores at the National Exams; accredited teachers/teacher professional development; security; cafeteria for all including staff; clinic and nurse for first aid; and a very good reputation. Note: Pre School celebrated 2nd Anniversary on Oct 1 and Kindergarten celebrated 1st Anniversary.
