**Saint Gabriel School Year 2023-2024**—Francesca noted St Gabriel 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter good news: entire school started on 9/11/2023 with Mass; enrollment was the highest due to a strong pre/K-13<sup>th</sup> Grade/754 students; very good administrators; close to excellent scores at the National Exams; accredited teachers/teacher professional development; security; cafeteria for all including staff; clinic and nurse for first aid; and a very good reputation. <u>Note</u>: Pre School celebrated 2<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary on Oct 1 and Kindergarten celebrated 1<sup>st</sup> Anniversary. - 2. In chapter 14, Tom receives a letter from a man named Venel Lamay (page 175 at the bottom through page 177 at the top). What are your first impressions of this letter and what Venel did for Tom?
