MINISTRIES' UPDATED REPORTS

1. BREAD FOR THE WORLD'S OFFERING OF LETTERS | Mike

Mike reported that Bread for the World, Writing of Letters will take place in the Commons, April 20th and 21st. after Masses. Stations of the Cross lead by J&P (Mike), is scheduled Friday, March 15th.

- 2. <u>CARE FOR CREATION</u> | Frank reported that the members of that ministry met Mon., Jan. 22nd to discuss goals. The focus this year is to register with Laudato Si Action Platform. There are 7 areas of concern. The Ministry will focus on 2 for the parish. Clean the Street quarterly action is scheduled for Sat., March 16, 8:30am -10:00 am. Please bring your gloves. Keep Norfolk Beautiful will provide the necessary equipment. The next meeting will be Mon. March 18th, 7:00 pm. No meeting in Feb. due to the Mission of the Church 3-day event. Some members will attend this parish event.
- 3. <u>CATHOLIC WORKER</u> | Steve sent this report. The Norfolk Catholic Worker continues to serve a meal on the street 3 mornings a week and to help house a couple dozen people. We can use volunteers on the soupline and, right now, can use ground coffee and as-large-as-possible men's winter gloves. We have an ongoing vigil against war and for nonviolence and nuclear disarmament, as well as one proclaiming Black Lives Matter, as unarmed Black people continue to disproportionately be killed.
- 4. <u>CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES</u> (CRS) | Frank noted that Sacred Heart is part of the VA CRS Chapter. This group meets via Zoom, the 3rd Wed. of each month to discuss how CRS is addressing climate change, damage done by conflicts and wars. If you wish to attend the CRS Chapter meeting, please contact Frank. Also, to encourage letter writing to state legislators. Frank & Patricia met with Sister Linh regarding CRS Rice Bowl, on Tues., Jan.16. They will set the CRS table in the Commons, Wed. Feb. 12, the day after Mardi-Gras: cardboard bowls, calendar of suggested activities, posters, etc. Bulletin notes have been sent.
- 5. DIGNITY OF LIFE | Patricia reported that the Writing Easter Cards to Elders Workshop is scheduled on Mon., March 11, 10:00 am-11:15 am. Tony and Patricia make regular visits to the Planned Parenthood Center in VA Beach to have a Prayerful Presence. Tony attended the March for Life Jan. 19th, Washington DC. Dan Doyle, Patricia & others will go to the March for Life, Feb. 21st, Richmond. We continue our partnership with Hope 4 Life and Crisis Pregnancy Center.
- 6. <u>HAITI TWINNING</u> | Francesca noted HTM met Jan. 2nd. Fr. Paul made the 2nd quarterly wire transfer in Jan. for SG in support of the Lunch, Medical, Teachers, and Self-Sustaining Projects Funds. Susie continues sending Birthday cards for pen pals, and Francesca, notes from pen pals. The Jan. 20th indoor sale helped feed 1 student for 11 months. Next meeting is Feb. 20, 6:00 pm-7:30 pm. Francesca, William, and Patricia to attend the Diocese Annual Haiti Gathering at St. Bede, Feb. 17th. Guest speaker: Richard Joseph, Director of Education, Diocese of Richmond. School continues going well.
