Fitho's future visits & SHP pilgrimages, we continue learning the basics of the Haitian Creole language. Members reviewed The Sign of the Cross and sang Mange Sa a before dinner.

<u>2024</u>—**The Lambi's Call**, Breaking the Chains by Dr. Tom Fame, Chapters 10-12: Patricia led the discussion on the following questions provided by Brendan:

- 1. <u>In Chapter 10</u>, we learn about the "Sol". What do you think of this unique banking arrangement?
