As of tradition, the Haiti Twinning Ministry sale team participated in this festive event coordinated by Susan Posey and her team of volunteers. She said "This is the best party in Hampton Road. People can do their holiday shopping, enjoy live music, taste chocolate, eat good food, drink local beer, and meet friends." We shared a table with Sowers of Justice who sold a variety of Divine chocolate. Also, nearby our friends from Holy Family Catholic Church sold <u>Peace Cycle</u> bags from recycling plastic bags collected in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. Other vendors filled the room with various items: jewelry, scarves, jackets, hand soaps and creams, baskets, art, textiles, ornaments and many other merchandize. We sold 10 bags of Just Haiti coffee and have just ordered 60 fresh bags.

The total collected from the 2 sales of various items including costume jewelry, cat toys, and Haitian art and generous free donations was \$952 for the Teacher's Endowment. This amount represents 9 months of a teacher's salary.

This month we applied our friends who made handmade items: cat toys, handbags, bath sponges, and jewelry.
